Round House Capacity Campaign Update



The campaign is going from strength to strength and Cambridgeshire County Council do

now seem to accept there is a long term problem with primary school provision on Love's Farm. However, they are still currently refusing to find a solution for September 2017. We really believe we have a strong case and will be presenting our petition and argument at the next Council Committee meeting in June.

We've been overwhelmed by the response we've received so far and it's really shown what a truly wonderful community Love's Farm is. We've been so encouraged to know this is an issue many people feel strongly about and it has made us even more determined to fight for our children's right to attend the local school.

Whilst the vast majority of feedback we've received has been positive, we are aware that a few parents have some concerns and we want to make it clear that we are

campaigning for a permanent increase to the capacity of the school. This will involve building new classrooms, but also increasing communal areas (hall, kitchen, etc.) We are not trying to squeeze more children into existing space and class sizes will not get any bigger (they are already at the maximum of 30). Although Portakabins may have to be used for a short while, this will only be temporary. We really believe this will benefit all of the pupils and children on Love's Farm as well as the wider community.

We will be at The Great Get Together on 18 June and would love to meet you if you'd like to find out more about the campaign or just show support. There's lots more information on our website too: www.roundhousecampaign.co.uk.
