## Full Steam Ahead for Wintringham

Love's Farm residents won't have missed the recent increased activity on the Wintringham site, directly south of Love's Farm.

Work has begun to create the roads, drainage and landscaping that connect the new development to Cambridge Road. Master Developer Urban&Civic has told Love's Farm Community Association (LFCA) that there are no planned closures for Cambridge Road but temporary

traffic lights will be necessary from February. Please keep an eye on [www.ourlovesfarm.co.uk](http://www.ourlovesfarm.co.uk) and [www.facebook.com/ourlovesfarm](https://www.facebook.com/ourlovesfarm) for the latest news as we receive it.

Meanwhile, plans for the first homes have been submitted to HDC. CALA Homes hopes to build 184 houses and 38 flats on the land to the south-east of the roundabout where Cambridge Road meets Stone Hill. The plans include a variety of

designs including a mix of affordable and commercial homes. Nearly all houses have two off-street parking bays, with many also including a garage. The flats have just one parking bay each, and there are only 18 visitor bays for all 222 dwellings.

A separate planning application has been submitted for Wintringham Primary Academy, the first of two primary schools to be built on the development. The three-form entry school will be able to accommodate up to 630 pupils, plus a further 78 in its pre-school facility. The building has a distinctive avocado-shaped

design, with an oval roof and an internal courtyard, nicknamed The Grove, featuring London plane and Chinese red birch trees.

LFCA has campaigned to ensure there are sufficient pedestrian crossings on Cambridge Road to connect the Love's Farm and Wintringham developments, not least because the Round House school is unable to accommodate all the children on Love's Farm. As a result, many of them will be attending Wintringham Primary Academy instead. We were disappointed that the original plans (approved by HDC in February 2018) included just a single controlled crossing, located to the west of Dramsell Rise — fine for Wintringham residents heading into town or to the station but little use to Love's Farm children heading to Wintringham school. As such, it's a big relief to see that a second controlled crossing has now been added, located between Love's Way and Belland Hill.

Other planning permission documents include a Section 106 Agreement, which specifies what infrastructure and community facilities

Urban&Civic must deliver. These include a temporary community building by the time 100 homes are occupied, with a permanent community building coming online by the time 1,675 homes are occupied. A health centre is also mentioned but details are yet to be agreed.

A Community Development Worker must be appointed before any homes are occupied. LFCA looks forward to working with this person to ensure that the communities of Love's Farm and Wintringham grow in support of one another.

## Love's Farm Out of Doors

February is probably no-one's favourite month, unless you have a birthday, but there is still quite a lot of interesting wildlife to observe. Our native birds, those not wintering in the southern sun, are easier to spot because there are no leaves on the trees and there are some exciting foreign visitors too. Let me see if I can make bird spotting easy!

Lots of little birds chattering in some bushes:

if they are all the same small size and saying the same thing they are probably tree sparrows;

if differing small sizes and speaking different languages they may be "mixed tits and finches", blue, great, coal and marsh tits, with goldfinches and other hangers-on;

if they are middle sized, a bit higher

in bushes or trees and sound like a football crowd they'll be starlings.

Now the exciting ones — if they are quite mixed in size, not very noisy but "chittery" they could be redwings from Iceland, our local thrushes and fieldfares visiting from Northern Europe, all come together to share our crab apples, quinces and hawthorn berries.

You may spot them flying first but the same rules apply. Starlings on Love's Farm are building up in numbers so that we can have our own aerial shows, known as murmurations.

Birds on their own are our well known blackbird (he's black with a yellow beak, she's brown), robin and tiny wren who usually sounds in a bad mood — "chipping" out of some ivy. Special alone is a little egret, a small white heron-shaped bird. He has been around for some time and I would love him to make a home in the reeds behind the Pirate Ship.

We have two types of woodpecker, green, often on the ground eating ant larvae, and the smaller, flash of black, white and red, the great spotted. And

two big raptors (meat-eaters) flying high, red kite with a forked tail and buzzard with a "hole" in each wing and a cry like a human baby!

Lastly, for now, Mr and Mrs carrion crow. There may be two couples but you won't see them together, they

just walk round eating worms and fly off with a squawk when disturbed.

Happy twitching (that's what bird watchers are called) and let me know if you spot something different or exciting.
