International Women's Day is a global celebration of the social, economic, cultural, and political achievements of women, and a call to accelerate women's equality. The first IWD gathering took place in 1911, with over a million supporters. Today, IWD is not country, group or organisation specific, but belongs to all groups collectively everywhere.

We first held this event in 2024, and after great feedback, we are hosting it again! It's set to be a great opportunity for women across the area to connect and celebrate. The event will have three strands:

Connect: Bring along business cards, leaflets or any other items that show what you do! Put them on

display and connect with others who want to learn about your business, your passion or your hobbies.

We also invite attendees to speak for 5 minutes on a topic of their choice. Subjects specific to women are particularly welcome, such as pregnancy and menopause.

Celebrate: Shout about women's achievements. Big or small, we want to hear them and celebrate them, both your own and those of other women you know. We will have a virtual system running on the night to capture all of these wonderful achievements.

Chat: Come along just to chat to others. Get to know people in your community. Chat with others in a welcoming and friendly environment.
